Flight to Bear Country

Enjoy a 50 minute floatplane ride with scenic views of Cook Inlet then board a boat to head to where bears are known to fish for an amazing view of these magnificent creatures.



Denali National Park

Visit the vast national park surrounding Mount McKinley, the tallest mountain in North America, home to an abundance of wildlife spot bears, caribou and wolves.



Winter Lake Lodge Retreat

Experience the Alaskan wilderness at one of Alaska's most remote lodges; arrive by floatplane for 2 days of wildlife viewing and gourmet meals. Optional adventures include helicopter glacier trek and sport fishing. Package includes a night in Anchorage and city tour.



Canadian Rockies

Board the legendary Rocky Mountaineer train and relax as you watch stunning vistas including Columbia Icefields in Jasper National Park, Hell's Gate in Fraser Canyon and Kicking Horse Canyon.



Vancouver

Explore this vibrant city, easily accessible on foot the streets of Gastown and the exotic sights of Chinatown. Take a water taxi to Granville Island with its wonderful market and open air cafes. See the colourful totem poles, giant cedars, beaches and gardens of Stanley Park.



Japan

From Otaru fly to Hiroshima and visit the Peace Memorial Park. Travel by bullet train to Kyoto and visit Nijo Castle, Kinkakuji Temple and the Kasuga Taisha Shrine. Board the elegant JR Super Express to Tokyo to complete your tour.



Lake Akan & Kushiro

Explore Otaru before flying to Memambetsu. A scenic drive takes you to lozan to 'Sulphur Mountain' and see the world's most transparent lake: Lake Mashu and onto Lake Akan. Enjoy a walking tour of Kushiro Marshland, home to the Japanese crane and other birdlife before finishing your tour in Tokyo.



St. Petersburg

If visiting the White Seas area you could visit the romantic city of St. Petersburg. Explore the beautiful canals, grand palaces and galleries including the Hermitage, once a winter palace now one of the world's oldest and largest museums of art and culture.
